1. It is a surface water sport in which the sportsman rides a board on the crest and face of a wave, which is carrying him towards the shore. Waves suitable for this sport are found in the ocean, but are also sometimes found in lakes and rivers, and also in manmade wave pools.

2. It is a sport that involves a slope that is covered with snow. A rider uses a special boots and board. It was developed in the U.S.A. in the 1960s to 1970s and became a Winter Olympic Sport in 1998.

3. It is an activity in which participants climb up, down or across natural rock formations or artificial rock walls. The goal is to reach the top of a formation without falling. It can be a dangerous sport and you should know proper techniques and usage of special equipment. While not an Olympic event, it is recognized by the International Olympic Committee as a sport.

5. It is an activity in which participants explore wild whole space in the ground, especially a natural underground space large enough for a human to enter.
